





To guide and inspire our teachers and students, we organized lectures to guide about the invention competition. Dr. R.D. Gholap, Prof. K.R. Adhav, Prof. V.G. Gaikwad guided through lectures on research project preparation, research methodology, hypothesis, potential areas of research and research project presentation etc. The competition was inaugurated by Principal Dr.R.D.Darekar. - Employment opportunities are available through Avishkar research project.






