According to the 2019 credit pattern of Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune, Industrial Visit is required to get extra credit for FY/SY/TY. BCom students. According to that, the students of commerce department in our college d. Visited "Sapro Foods Farmer Producer Company" Borgaon, Saputara on 06/05/2023.

During this visit the Director of Sapro Foods Farmer Producer Company Mr. Amol Kardile (Education-Engineering Degree) guided the students and gave information about the establishment of the company as well as the production.

Sapro Foods Farmer Producer Company was established in the year 2016. Between 2016 and 2019, the unit of this company was located at Saputara. After 2019, the company's unit came near Nashik-Saputara Road Borgaon due to increase in raw material manufacturers in rural areas like Borgaon. The name of this company is Sapro "Sa-Saputara" and "Pro-Product" means product of Saputara. There are total 280 farmer members in this company. Also, a total of 100 employees works in different departments. This company has two main divisions namely Cold Storage and Processing Unit.

Director of the company Mr. Amol Kardile while guiding the students gave the following information about the purpose of setting up the company.

- 1) The company has been established for the benefit of the farmers and to revolutionize the agricultural sector in Maharashtra.
- 2) Through this organization, to motivate the children of every farmer for agricultural education, create public awareness about agricultural facilities and new technology, cultivation of agricultural produce, handling, packaging etc. Doing the process properly.
- 3) Preparation of processed food on agricultural products, providing direct market for the farmer, increasing the profit of the farmers by saving the production cost of the farmers by implementing collective farming activities.
- 4) Helping to increase production by creating new crop species in agriculture, promoting agrobased industries and organizing mentoring workshops.
- 5) To make available to the farmers various tools like seeds, chemical fertilizers, organic fertilizers, medicines, etc. at cheap and fair prices to get benefits through various government schemes like group farming.



Company's Product -

Amla, Guava, Jambhul, Mango, Strawberry, Dragan Food, Apple, Tutu etc. through this company. Various products are prepared by processing the fruit.

- 1) Chocolates guava, mango, strawberry, apple etc. Fruit jelly candies are prepared by processing the fruit.
- 2) Guava & Mango Drink Cold drinks are prepared by processing Guava, Mango, Jabhu.
- 3) Jamun Crush and Powder Jamun Crush is prepared by processing Jambhu. Jamun powder is widely used as a remedy for diabetes.
- 4) Strawberry Jam This is widely used for cakes. It is also a favourite among children.

Along with this, this company has planted various types of fruit trees on about 10 to 15 acres of agricultural area in Agro-Tourism as Sapro Agro-Tourism. These include apple, amla, guava, purple, mango, strawberry, Dragan food, avocado, tutu, tejpan, fanas, orange and lemon etc. A fruit tree has been planted. The purpose of this is to make children in urban areas know about real fruit trees. Along with this, a nursery has been prepared for the sale of seedlings of various fruit trees.


