





Department of History in the college celebrated Martyr's Day (Shahid Din) on 23 March 2023. Freedom fighters Bhagat Singh, Rajguru and Sukhdev who fought against the British to get freedom for their country were sentenced to death by the British government on 23 March 1931. Today is celebrated as 'Martyr's Day' in his memory. Lala Lajpat Rai, who opposed the British Simon Commission, died in a lathi charge by the British. Because of this, Chandrasekhar Azad, Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, Sukhdev and other revolutionaries decided to avenge Lalaji's death. Finally, on 17 December 1928, he shot and killed the British officer Saunders. In this case, the British arrested Bhagat Singh, Rajguru and Sukhdev and sentenced them to death. In the said program, the students of history department discussed the ideology of Shaheed Bhagat Singh, information about Rajguru and Sukhdev, what is revolution? Information was presented on these topics. 30 students attended this program.
